
I would like to commend your company for the work executed at the new Woolworths, Mall of Africa.

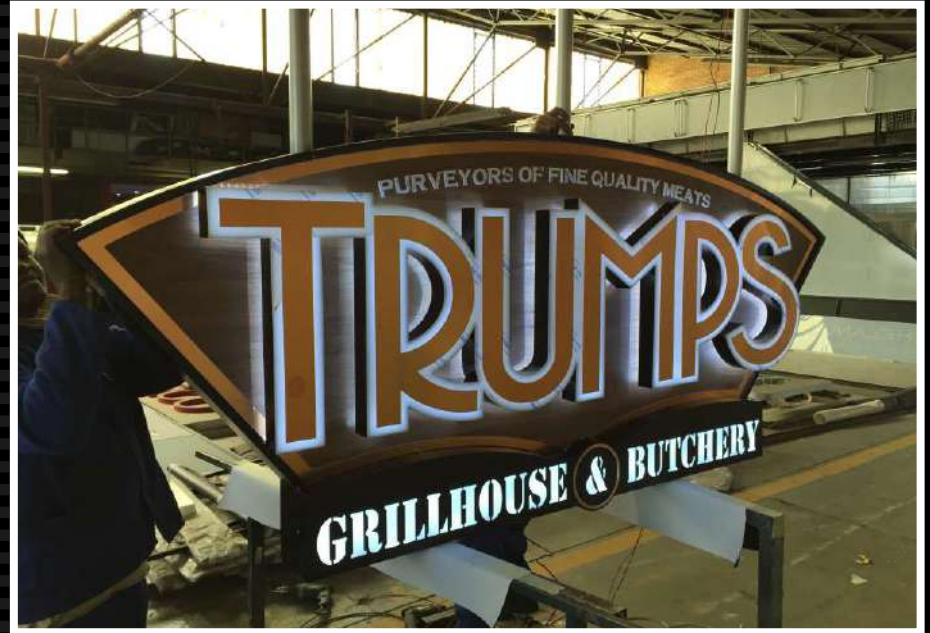

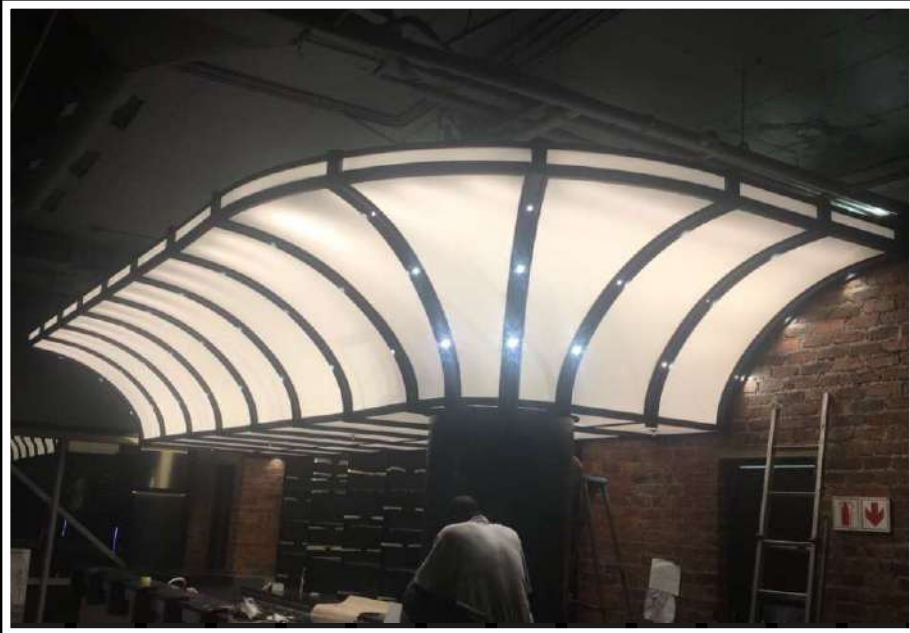
